**ORDER**

For the reasons in the accompanying Memorandum Order issued this same date, defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment is hereby **DENIED IN-PART** insofar as the search was inadequate, and as FBI 935–938 and FBI 1151–1152 were improperly redacted.

It is further **ORDERED** that defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED IN-PART** insofar as the exemptions invoked to redact or withhold FBI 458–460 and FBI 1268–1269 were properly applied.

It is further **ORDERED** that plaintiff’s Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment is **DENIED IN-PART** insofar as the FBI’s withholdings in part or in full of FBI 458–460 and FBI 1268–1269 are proper.

It is further **ORDERED** that plaintiff’s Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED IN-PART** insofar as the FBI’s search was inadequate, and the withholdings in part or in full of FBI 935–938 and FBI 1151–1152 are not proper.

The parties are hereby **ORDERED** to meet and confer to determine appropriate terms for future searches. If the parties cannot agree to appropriate terms, plaintiffs may submit a proposed


order with suggested search terms to the Court. Defendants will respond within seven (7) days of that proposed order.

Defendants are further **ORDERED** to produce a version of FBI 935-938 and 1151-1152 that is compliant with the instructions in the accompanying memorandum opinion.

Defendants are further **ORDERED** to replace all of the previously redacted names in the responsive documents, as well as any redacted names in documents responsive to future searches, with alphanumeric markers, which are to be uniquely identifiable and consistent throughout all documents produced pursuant to this FOIA request.

It is **SO ORDERED**.
