# Candidates Aim Talks At Women

D.C. delegate candidate Dr. Franklin E. Kameny told members of Federally Employed Women, Inc., yesterday they must fight to achieve equality just as he is fighting for equal opportunities for the homosexual community.

Kameny spoke at a forum with four other candidates, James Harris, of the Socialist Workers Party; John A. Nevius, the Republican nominee; Julius W. Hobson, Statehood Party candidate, and the Rev. Walter Fauntroy, the Democratic nominee.

Kameny said that the basic problem in "the women's liberation movement is that not enough women have realized "the situation they're in."

"A lot of women are discriminated against purely because of their sex," Kameny told the group of about 50 women, "but I think the formation of your body and your
